

TCC Quarterly Savings Membership

- Minimum 3-month (contiguous) commitment
- \$145*/month (\$435 initial payment)
- Get full studio access with personal entry code
- Includes artist's page/bio on website (after 6-months of membership)
- Offers gallery participation
- Receive store discount of 10% on clay
- Personal shelves
- Storage locker based on availability @ \$15/mo
- Firing fees additional

TCC Annual Giving Membership

- Full-year commitment
- \$130*/mo paid semi-annually (\$780)
- Get full studio access with personal entry code
- Includes all benefits of the Quarterly Membership, including 10% store discount on clay, artist's page/bio on website (after 6 months), and gallery participation, PLUS free 36" x 12" x 15" locker (a \$180 annual value)
- Firing fees additional

TCC FlexPass – 6x or 12x

- \$85* for 6x / \$160 for 12x
- Each segment is equivalent to 3-4 hours of studio use over a period of up to 60 days.
- Includes shared wet clay/drying shelving space, but does not include a locker.
- Personal shelves @ \$15/mo when available
- Use of Glaze room; studio glaze fees apply
- Firing fees additional

Firing Fees

Firing fees are classified as Member and Nonmember. Members pay \$3.00/lb for bisque and glaze combined. Non-members pay \$1.75/lb for bisque and \$2.00/lb for ^5-6 glaze. Anything larger than 10", in any one direction, is subject to a \$.01/cubic inch surcharge.

Contract Firing

TCC offers contract firing at current nonmember rates. Electric kilns may be rented for bisque and/or cone 5-6: Skutt 1227 for \$105 and the Skutt test kiln at \$35. TCC reserves the right to deny any non-member access to contract firing.

Glaze Material Fees

*Flex*Pass and other non-members may use studio glazes at \$2.00/lb per bisqued piece.

Extra Benefits for Long-Term Membership

Members committed to a long-term membership at TCC (after a minimum of 6 contiguous months), will become eligible for some great benefits that include:

- Ability to participate in member shows and gallery events (following gallery approval).
- Displaying work in the TCC online gallery (after 6 months of continuous membership).
- Memberships paid annually, in full, will have \$130 donated to the TCC Scholarship Fund.

Classes and Workshops

The TCC offers 8-week class sessions throughout the year for adults and kids that include wheel throwing, hand-building, raku, sculpture, and more. Workshops are periodically hosted at the TCC and taught by ceramics pros, from near and far. The TCC will also do its best to accommodate requests for private lessons, individual or group. PLEASE NOTE: All memberships and passes are subject to an 8.69% local, county, and NM state GRT tax. All members and others using the TCC studio must attend a short orientation prior to using the studio facilities. Firing fees are based on weight of bisqued pieces before glazing.
